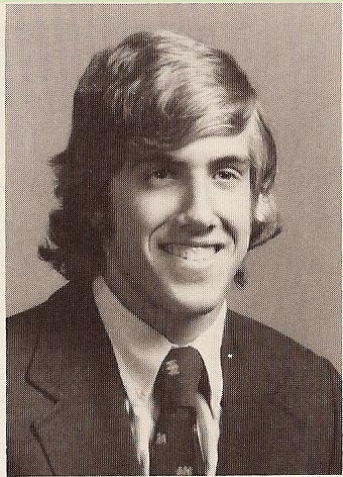


Steve Mays Class of 1975

History of Carroll Tree Service

Henry J. Carroll founded Carroll Tree Service in 1950. He sincerely believed in delivering excellent customer service and superior workmanship to his customers. Hank was a true gentleman, and he gained the trust of many home owners and built a solid reputation for the company. As a businessman, he was always honest, polite, and respectful to his clients and employees. Hank passed away in the summer of 1987, but his work philosophy still remains today.

Today, Carroll Tree Service is managed daily by Hank's successors: Rob Nelson, Steve Mays Sr, and Frank Dudek. Rob joined Carroll Tree in 1972 when Hank invited him to become a partner. In April 1988, Steve Mays Sr., became a partner when Mays Tree Experts merged with the company. Carroll Tree continued to grow and in January 2000, Frank Dudek, became the third partner.

During the late eighties, Carroll had only a few dump trucks and chippers. Twenty years later, we have top-of the line equipment and a fleet of over 40 trucks. By far, the most valuable asset to Carroll Tree is a team of more than 35 well-trained professional employees. Jim Bowles, Papo Rosado, and Dave Holyfield have been with the company for over 20 years. Our staff also includes three Maryland licensed pesticide applicators, seven ISA certified arborists, and eight Maryland licensed tree experts. All certified arborists at Carroll Tree are actively involved in the Maryland Arborist Association, the International Society of Arboriculture and the Tree Care Industry Association.

Carroll Tree Service has become one of the oldest, most respected tree companies in the Baltimore area. We are confident in the future of the company; in January 2006, Steve Mays Sr. became the president of Carroll Tree Service.
