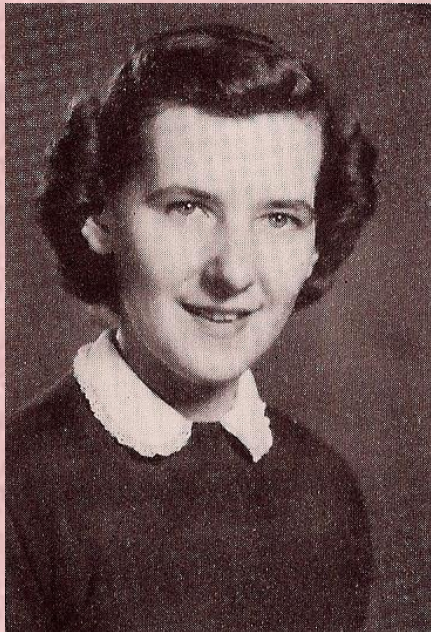


Nancy Reter Stocksdale Class of 1952
