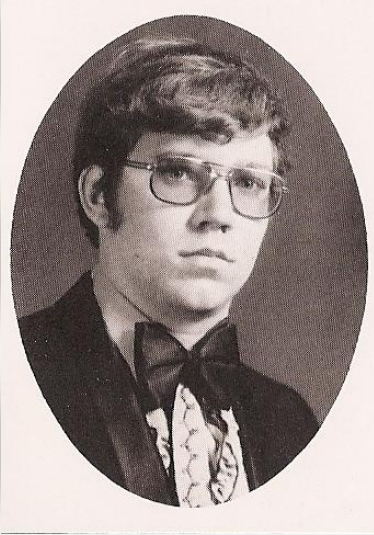


## Charlie Wright – Class of 1974 CFO The Kroenke Group
